The Minack Theatre, carved out of the granite cliff tops over 80 years ago, is one of the world's most famous outdoor amphitheatres in a truly stunning setting.

RLT and Stroma Building Control worked together on the complete re-build of the actors' changing room facilities back in 2010-2011. This latest scheme involves alterations to the backstage facilities building by extending the roof at second floor level with a new pitched roof and creating a third floor storage area.
